- **Contribution to GDP:** The poultry industry contributes significantly to South Africa's agricultural GDP, accounting for around 16-18% of the total agricultural output. Poultry production was notably high, with over 170 million chickens produced.

The livestock sector is one of the most important components of South Africa's agricultural economy, Contributing approximately 42–47% of the total agricultural GDP.

- **Largest Agricultural Subsector:** Poultry (especially broiler production) is the largest segment of South Africa's agricultural sector.
- **Broiler Production:** This dominates the sector, supplying chicken meat to the local market. Chicken is the most consumed protein in South Africa.
- **Export and Import:** South Africa is a net importer of poultry meat, with imports (mainly from Brazil, the EU, and the US) competing with local producers. However, South Africa also exports poultry products to neighboring African countries.
- **Investment Potential:** With strategic investment in processing, genetics, and disease control, SA can become a major player in the global poultry & livestock markets.
